**12th Annual One Earth Film Festival theme 'Let's Get Loud!'
calls on audience to advocate with gusto for the climate emergency**

OAK PARK, IL Jan. 11, 2023 – One Earth Film Festival returns March 3 to 12, 2023 for its 12th festival season with thoughtfully curated film events that will be streamed online, with a number of in-person screenings and events that highlight the importance of speaking out and taking action on climate change. Expert panels and workshops will allow attendees to learn and participate in the fight for a sustainable future.

The Festival chose the theme "Let's Get Loud!" to amplify the urgency for a broader responsibility to advocate for the climate emergency. "Let's Get Loud!" are the words of [Dr. Katherine Hayhoe](#), a renowned climate scientist who said that the most important action we can do to fight climate change is to talk about it. Through invigorating and thought-provoking films and discussions, the Festival calls on audiences to join the fight, speak up, and get loud about climate change.

The 2023 Festival kicks off with an exclusive Preview Party **on Thursday, Jan. 26, at 7 p.m.** at the Matthew Bieszczat Volunteer Resource Center, 6100 North Central Ave. in Chicago. This elegant event space is accented by beautiful, high wooden ceilings and is hidden in the Forest Preserves of Cook County overlooking the Edgebrook golf course. "Since its inception, One Earth has stressed the importance of taking collective action," Festival director Ana Garcia Doyle said.
